DAY 1, Tuesday, September 21, 2027 - Depart USA

DAY 2, Wednesday, September 22 - Arrive in Amsterdam

Arrive in Amsterdam and transfer to your hotel. Most flights arrive in the early morning and your room may not be ready for you. In this case, leave your luggage with the concierge and your Tour Manager will provide suggestions for you to begin to explore the city on your own. Your tour begins with an orientation meeting with your Tour Manager at approximately 6 PM, followed by dinner. We recommend that you select flights which arrive no later than 4 PM

DAY 3, Thursday, September 23 - Amsterdam Canal Tour

This morning, board a glass-top boat for a cruise of the winding canals of historic Amsterdam for an up-close view of stately historic mansions, 16th century gabled merchant houses, and charming churches with bell towers. The afternoon is at leisure. Tonight, perhaps join the *optional* Dutch Country Village with Dinner Tour. Head outside Amsterdam this afternoon to Volendam, a charming fishing village on the old Zuiderzee. Take a stroll through the maze of its quaint alleyways. Next, visit a former farm and watch a cheese and clog making demonstration, followed by a Dutch dinner of local specialties with drinks included.

DAY 4, Friday, September 24 - Travel to Bruges

Travel through Holland's open fields crisscrossed with canals and windmills to reach Belgium. Journey to the city of Bruges, also known as the "Venice of the North," home to some of Europe's best-preserved medieval buildings. In the afternoon*, walk along the cobbled lanes of the city's medieval district to Our Lady's Church, housing the famous Madonna statue by Michelangelo. Continue past the Market Square with its 13th century Belfry, one of Bruges' most famous landmarks, and the Town Hall Square with its Chapel of the Holy Blood. Tonight, dinner is in a local restaurant

DAY 5, Saturday, September 25 - Travel to Paris

Depart Bruges and travel to Paris where you will have the evening at leisure, or you can join the *optional* Evening in Paris with dinner. Discover the "City of Light" at night and savor dinner in a typical French bistro

DAY 6, Sunday, September 26 - Paris City Tour

Drive along the impressive Champs Elysees to the Arc de Triomphe, Concorde Square, and the stately Eiffel Tower, symbol of Paris**. On to the celebrated "Rive Gauche", the vivacious Left Bank, where artists, philosophers and writers in a long-gone era flourished in the artistic community at Montparnasse. View the Latin Quarter, home to many of France's higher education establishments, including the Sorbonne. Following the city tour, spend the rest of the day at leisure or join the *optional* tour to the magnificent Palace of Versailles*. The tour takes you to the opulent Palace of Versailles to witness the grandeur of French classical architecture. Step inside the sumptuous palace and visit the extravagant state apartments including a guided visit to the Reception Halls, the Royal Bedroom, and the Hall of Mirrors. Free time for lunch on your own in one of the on-site cafes

DAY 7, Monday, September 27 - Full Day in Paris

Today is at leisure in Paris. Don't miss the *optional* Grand Louvre Museum Tour. This Grand Louvre walking tour begins with a stroll through the commercial area outside the Louvre and continues inside the museum where an experienced guide will present to you various exhibitions. Of the many exhibitions found therein, this tour covers those of the medieval fortress, the modern pyramid, the Egyptian Department, and some of the museum's most reputed masterpieces, including Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa.

DAY 8, Tuesday, September 28 – Travel to London via the Chunnel

Transfer to the Gare du Nord train station for your trip to London via the Chunnel, a 31-mile-long underwater tunnel. Upon arrival, meet your coach and guide to start your panoramic tour of London. Begin with a drive through the city center and proceed to view Piccadilly Circus, Trafalgar Square, Westminster Abbey, the Houses of Parliament, and the famous Big Ben. Continue to view Buckingham Palace, the London residence of His Majesty the King
